

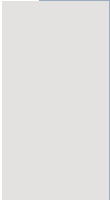

Vision

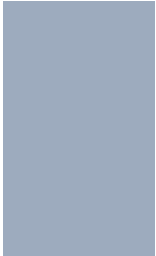
To raise up a generation of Spirit-filled believers who live from the secret place, walk in intimacy with God, and carry a prophetic voice that brings transformation to Thailand and the nations.

Mission

The Wellspring equips disciples to hear God's voice, walk in spiritual authority, and minister from deep intimacy with the Holy Spirit. Through teaching, prophetic training, intercession, and discipleship, we cultivate overflowing voices that release life, healing, and truth into a dry and thirsty world.

WHAT IS THE WELLSPRING?

The Wellspring is not a university course or an academic program.

It is an intensive prophetic discipleship program designed to form followers of Jesus into spiritually mature believers who can clearly hear God's voice, discern with wisdom, and respond with courage.

The program operates within a house-of-prayer environment where worship, Scripture, communion, and the presence of God are central. Students grow in a greenhouse-like setting through teaching, hands-on activation, reflection, and mentoring, aiming for life transformation, not merely getting information.

The Wellspring cultivates a community that is both courageous and sincere, where people do deep heart work, discover and steward their calling, and practice prophetic ministry grounded in Scripture, humility, holiness, and integrity.

It is designed to be a *source*, not a destination — equipping believers to carry the work of the Spirit back into their families, communities, nations, and spheres of influence.

The Wellspring is not a hype-driven conference, not a ministry school producing platform-seekers, not psychotherapy —though students may encounter inner healing through the Spirit— and not a seminary that is granting degrees or emphasizing academic papers.

Through teaching, mentoring, and hands-on ministry, you will be formed in your identity, strengthened in your gifts, and activated into your God-given calling.

The Wellspring is a four-week intensive that is designed for true immersion and transformation. Four weeks provide enough time to build spiritual rhythms, do deep heart work, and practice obedience — far beyond what a weekend retreat or conference can produce.

WEEK 1

IDENTITY & INTIMACY; LEARNING TO
HEAR GOD AS SON+DAUGHTER

We establish biblical identity, sonship, and intimacy with Jesus as the foundation of prophetic life. Students learn to hear God's voice clearly and discern the Spirit through Scripture, prayer, and community.

WEEK 3

PROPHETIC CALLING
THE VOICE & THE CHURCH

We move into activation and practice. Students learn to articulate what they hear with clarity, humility, and love, and begin ministering prophetically through encouragement, edification, and intercession in real scenarios.

WEEK 2

PROPHETIC FOUNDATIONS
THE SECRET PLACE & THE VOICE

We lay prophetic foundations rooted in Scripture, holiness, and intimacy with Jesus. Students learn how God speaks, how to discern His voice from noise, and how to steward revelation in the heart before releasing it.

WEEK 4

THE FELLOWSHIP OF HIS SUFFERINGS
CALLING TO BE SENT OUT.

Intimacy leads to obedience; obedience embraces suffering; suffering bears fruit. Calling is forged in surrender, and prophetic ministry becomes love that costs something.

01

ENCOUNTER: THE HOUSE OF PRAYER

The House of Prayer is the center of gravity for everything we do. Here we minister to the Lord through worship, intercession, and communion, cultivating a culture of presence, intimacy, and listening. Encounter is where revelation begins and where our hearts stay aligned with Jesus and His purposes.

02

FORMATION: THE WELLSPRING, STUDIES & TRAINING.

Formation is where disciples grow in identity, intimacy, discernment, and obedience. Through the Wellspring and other structured studies, we train believers to hear God, steward revelation, and mature in character and calling. Formation turns encounter into fruit and revelation into obedience.

COMMUNITY: HOUSE CHURCH & FELLOWSHIP

Community is where faith becomes relational, accountable, and embodied. In house church we gather around Scripture, worship, prayer, and the Table as a spiritual family. Here discipleship becomes shared life rather than theory, and calling is tested, affirmed, and strengthened in real relationships.

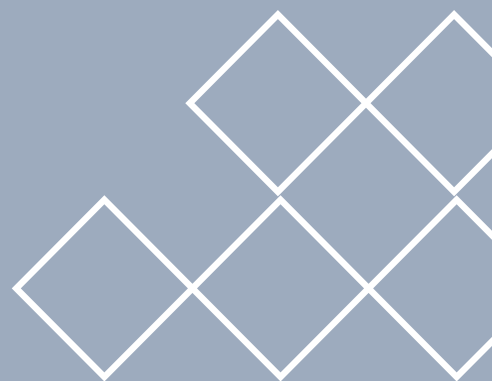
RESTORATION: MEMBER CARE + PASTORAL CARE + HEALING

Restoration is where hearts are healed and strengthened. Through member care, pastoral care, and healing ministry, we create a safe space to process pain, confront brokenness, and encounter the restoring work of the Holy Spirit. Restoration ensures that calling flows from wholeness and that leaders are healthy in heart as well as in gifting.

MISSION: CONFERENCES + RETREATS + MOBILIZATION

Mission is where encounter, formation, community, and restoration spill into the world. Through men's conferences, workshops, retreats, and regional gatherings, we mobilize believers to carry their calling into families, nations, and spheres of influence. Mission is how the work leaves the room.



Presence First

Our rhythm begins in worship, prayer, and Scripture. We linger. We listen. We minister to the Lord before we minister to one another.

LIFESTYLE + RHYTHMS

PRESENCE IS OUR CLASSROOM.



Sample Weekly Rhythm

7:00–8:00 AM — Solitude with Jesus

Unhurried time in Scripture, prayer, journaling, and listening. No one teaches here — we make space for Him.

8:00–11:30 AM — Teaching & Activations

Biblical foundations, prophetic training, discussion, and practical exercises.

11:30–1:30 PM — Lunch & Rest

Unhurried meals, fellowship, and space to breathe.

1:30–3:30 PM — Worship & Soaking

Presence-focused prayer, lingering worship, communion, and listening.

3:30–5:00 PM — Mentoring & Pastoral Check-ins

Personal and small-group mentoring for reflection, accountability, and discipleship.

Evenings — Community & Mission

House church, testimonies, intercession sets, shared meals, or practical outreach.

Weekends — Rest, Sabbath, & Adventure

Exploring Chiang Rai, prayer hikes, coffee shops, markets, waterfalls, and cultural immersion.



CODE OF COMMITMENT

Being part of the Wellspring means you're here to seek Jesus, not hype. We're pursuing intimacy with Him, growth in holiness, and honest obedience — not perfection. We honor each other, ditch gossip, own our mistakes, and stay teachable. We practice the prophetic with humility and love, without using gifts to impress or control. We protect trust and vulnerability, choose courage over fear, and refuse entitlement or platform-chasing. When conflict pops up, we reconcile fast and tell the truth without shaming. We honor leadership, fight for unity, and remember that authority comes through surrender and service, not noise. In short: we're here to pursue Jesus, grow up, love well, and actually live what we say we believe.

APPLICATIONS & PROCESS

The Wellspring is a four-week cohort designed for immersion, formation, and real growth. Because of the intensity of the program and the relational environment we cultivate, we ask applicants to complete a brief application, provide two references, and commit to the full four-week schedule. This process helps us discern fit, prepare well, and welcome students into a community that takes pursuit of Jesus.

Due to the immersive nature of the Wellspring, students agree to be present for the full four weeks, honor the rhythms of the program, and engage in the community with humility, honesty, and pursuit. We are not looking for perfection, résumé, or performance—only hunger, willingness, and commitment.

What You Need to Apply

- Short Video (2-3 minutes) — Tell us why you want to attend the Wellspring and what you feel called to in this season.
- Two References — One spiritual (pastor/mentor/leader) and one personal (friend/peer who knows you well).
- Profile-Style Photo — Just so we can put a face to the name.
- Personal Information — Basic background, faith story, and contact details.
- Health & Medications Disclosure — So we can care for you well and avoid surprises.
- Availability Commitment — Confirmation that you can attend all four weeks of the cohort.
- Emergency Contact — Because life happens and we want to be responsible.



FEES AND COSTS

The Wellspring is designed to be accessible and affordable. For this first beta cohort, participants will secure their own housing and meals, and we are asking for donations to help cover operational expenses — printing and materials, transportation and fuel, scholarships, and basic ministry costs. We believe discipleship should require personal investment, not just enthusiasm. We ask each participant to contribute financially as they are able so that everyone carries weight and honors the process.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

WE WELCOME YOU!

The Wellspring is a spiritual family with an international heart. We welcome students from around the world who are hungry for Jesus and ready for formation. We will help with cultural orientation, practical logistics, and on-the-ground support so you can focus on what God is doing in you during these four weeks.

International Eligibility Requirements

- Valid passport (with at least 6 months remaining before expiration).
- Ability to participate and communicate in English and/or Thai (the Wellspring cohort will be conducted in both languages).
- Entry to Thailand on a tourist visa or visa exemption (depending on nationality).
- Responsibility to confirm visa requirements for your country and comply with Thai immigration regulations for the duration of your stay.
- Ability to cover costs including travel, housing, and transportation while in Thailand.
- Travel/health insurance for the duration of the cohort.
- Personal medications and health disclosures managed responsibly.
- Willingness to honor cultural norms and participate fully in the 4-week cohort.



WHAT SUCCESS LOOKS LIKE AFTER ONE MONTH

The Wellspring is designed to produce real spiritual formation and lasting transformation— not hype, not emotionalism, and not just information. At the end of four weeks, we consider this intensive successful when participants leave changed in measurable ways, marked by deeper devotion to Jesus and greater maturity in the Spirit.

We want participants to be able to honestly say:

"I know Jesus more deeply than I did before."

"I can recognize His voice with greater clarity."

"I have a sustainable lifestyle of prayer, worship, and Scripture."

"I understand my identity and calling more clearly."

"I have grown in humility, discernment, and spiritual maturity."

"I feel equipped to walk in spiritual authority and bold obedience."

"And I am ready to carry what God has deposited here into the world."
